said that Principal Prof. Talwar gave a special identity to the college in his short tenure of eight months in Karnaprayag College. Handing over of P.G. Bhawan of Art Faculty, getting 'B' grade with 2.34 C.G.P.A. in NAAC and five lakh rupees, distribution of Shri Sai Das Talwar scholarship to meritorious students, publication of monthly newsletter Monal and approval of five crore rupees in Pradhan Mantri Uchchatar Shiksha Abhiyan etc. will be counted among his special achievements. In his service of about 40 years, he had a creative and impeccable image as a professor in Uttarkashi, Barkot, Doiwala and in Chakrata and Karnaprayag College as Principal. 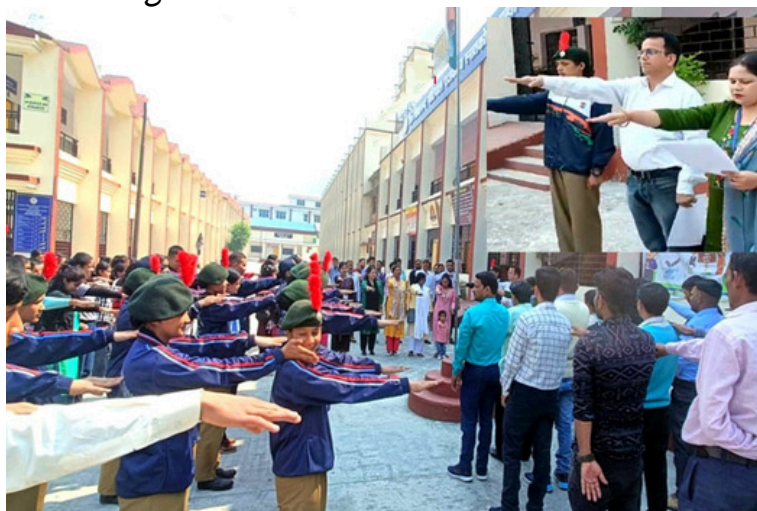




Beauty parlor training organized in the college under Skill India program

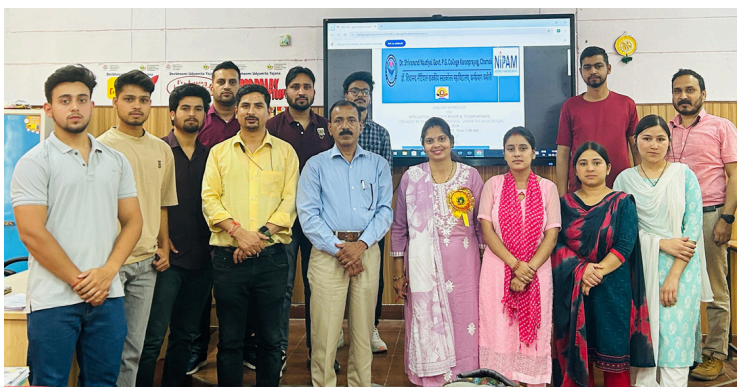




Council programs organized in the Department of Political Science
